

# Saxophone Sneak Downs

Low notes on the saxophone need:

- a steady blowing of air
- an open shape inside your mouth (like singing opera)
- an embouchure shaped like you are whistling (NOT shaped like you are a trout fish)
- your back teeth kept apart

\*The lines under the notes are called slurs. Tongue the first note of the measure and then DON'T tongue any of the notes that are contained in the slur line.
